PROPERTIES

The MICROGLASS putty is reinforced with glass fiber. Thanks to the use of elastic polyester resins and short glass fiber, it has much higher flexibility compared to other putties of this type with still high mechanical strength. Its easy and soft treatment makes the product suitable even for large surfaces. The MICROGLOSS has a low volume shrinkage which makes it possible to repair large defects. The product has good adhesion to various substrates, including galvanised steel. The product is intended for a wide range of applications in painting and finishing of metals, wood, concrete and plastics.


